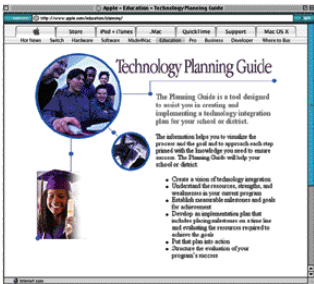

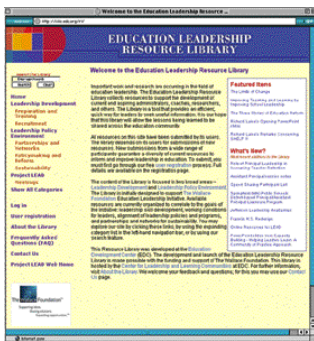
PARTNERSHIP FOR 21ST CENTURY SKILLS www.21stcenturyskills.org
