Did the kids benefit from what I did today?

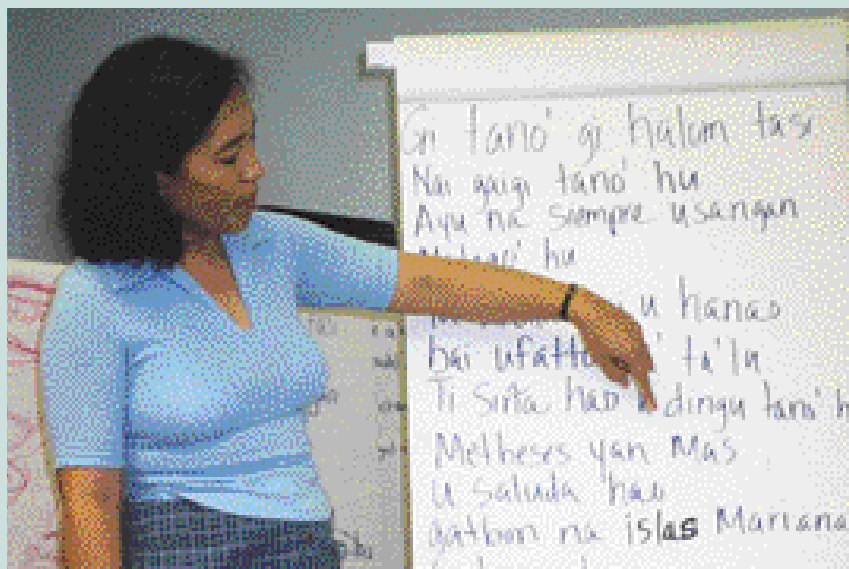
It is by continually challenging ourselves, as people and as educators, that we will be able to give our students the quality instruction they need.
