Hello	Tālofa	tah-LOH-fah
Good morning	Taeao manuia	tie-YOW mah-noo-WEE-ah
Good afternoon	Tālofa manuia le aso	tah-LOH-fah mah-noo-WEE-ah lay AH-so
Good evening	Manuia le afiafi	mah-noo-WEE-ah lay AH-fee-AH-fee
Good night	Manuia le pō	mah-noo-WEE-ah lay po
Thank you	Fa'afetai	FAH-ah-fay-TIE
You're welcome	Maliu mai	mah-LEE-yoo MY-ee <sup>†</sup>
Goodbye	Tōfā soifua	toh-FAH so-ee-FOO-ah
My name is (insert name).	O lo'u igoa o (insert name)	oh LOH-oo ee-NGO <sup>*</sup> -ah oh (insert name)
What is your name?	O ai lou igoa?	oh eye LOH ee-NGO <sup>*</sup> -ah?
